



Music This term we are fortunate to have a music specialist with us supporting our development of music provision. We will be exploring music, with a charanga unit based on 'Big bear funk' - developing rhythm and pulse. In term 2 we will focus on composing our own rhythms based on Tudor music!.

DT- We will be designing, building, and evaluating our own Tudor Houses. We will use a variety of materials and decide which are most suitable to create the buildings.

English We will explore fiction, non-fiction and poetry texts. Our first text will be 'The Dragon Machine'.



Writing Our focus will be to use capital letters, full stops, and spaces correctly. We will talk about our writing before we write and then read it to check it looks right and makes sense. We will continue to develop our stamina for writing and our independence.

Phonics and Reading -we will continue consolidating our phonics phases and we will enjoy reading a wide variety of texts as a class and individually. We will develop our reading skills segmenting and blending when needed and reading tricky words by sight.

Computing

We will focus on using technology safely. We will be using 'Scratch' an online application which develops programming skills. We will problem solve and debug the program as we create our own projects.



PSHE We will be understanding and respecting the similarities and differences between people. We will look at different families and how they are all special.

Summer

'Changes and Beginnings'

History- we will be investigating The Great Fire of London, researching the lifestyle and buildings of the time and why the fire spread so quickly. We will use music and drama to time travel back to 1666!

We will have opportunities to create and explore our 'Pudding Lane 'bakery role play area.



Maths We will continue with our White Rose scheme. Focussing on: Multiplication and division, Fractions, Geometry position and direction, Place value within 100, Money and Time. We will continue to develop our use of manipulatives and increase independence in our maths sessions.

Science This term we will be learning about observing plants and their growth -utilizing our outside growing area, to cultivate potatoes, beans, onions, sweetcorn, tomatoes, and strawberries! We will also plant wildflower areas to attract insect life to observe! We will focus on lifecycles of frogs, observe the changes of caterpillars to



butterflies and incubate our own chicks!

RE- Our focus will be Islam. In **Art**-We will investigate Islamic patterns, design, and create our own Islamic tiles from clay.



PE We are fortunate to have a specialist PE teacher supporting our development of PE over the summer term. We will continue to hone our listening skills, continue to develop balance, speed, and agility. We will be swimming in the second half term.
