### SWIMMING SESSIONS

We are excited to begin our swimming session at Aquastars Swimming Academy on Thursday 9th June 2022 for 6 weeks. The sessions will continue on Thursday afternoons and are thoroughly risk assessed so please be reassured that Covid-19 measures are in place and the safety of our children is first and foremost.

REMINDER - all children will need to bring a swimming kit bag with their costume/ trunks, a towel, a plastic bag (for wet items) and their own goggles if they usually wear these. We are not able to borrow goggles as previously due to restrictions. Swimming hats are not essential but long hair needs to be tied back neatly.

We will be leaving at 1.15pm and travel by hired coach. The coach will then transport our group back to school in time for 3.15 pick up. As you will appreciate bus hire in our rural area is hugely expensive, so we do request parents to help in this respect. A voluntary payment of £4 per child per week is requested and can be paid via School Gateway either weekly or in one payment of £24.

The children will be instructed by fully trained instructors by the poolside with a member of staff in the pool with our younger and non-swimmers.

We hope that this provision will enhance the PE provision at the school and in turn help the children to become water confident and progress in their swimming ability.

Many thanks for your support in making sure that each child has what they need for the session every Thursday.
